For those who have limited time on their hands but want to explore the beauty of the Solu region by immersing themselves in the beauty of magical landscapes and relishing the simple lifestyle and hospitality of different ethnic groups, Pikey peak trek is the ideal option. Trek Grade

Like other popular Himalayan destinations of Nepal, Pikey Peak does not lie at a high altitude, but it resides at the lap of other high summit Himalayas with an **altitude of 4065 m**. With the low altitude and somehow maintained trail, the Pikey Peak trek is considered to be an easy or **moderately difficult** trek.

There are no technical challenging parts of the trek apart from some steep uphill and strong wind blowing between the trail of Pikey Peak camp and pikey peak.

Trek Duration



The total distance to be covered in the Pikey Peak trek is about **50 to 60 km**. However, these distances can vary as per the itinerary of the route you have chosen.

Moreover, the trek can be completed in a **short time of about 5 to 7 days**, with an average hiking of about **5 to 7 hours per day**.

Best Season for Pikey Peak Trekking



When it comes to trekking in Nepal, the **autumn season (September to November)** and **spring season (March to May)** are preferred seasons, and the Pikey Peak trek is no

exception.

The fall season is the festive season, so you will be able to witness the cultural and religious variations among the people inhabiting the lower Solu region. Moreover, after the monsoon rain, the skies will be clear, providing you with an expansive view of mountain ranges from east to west.

Likewise, in the spring, you will be offered the blossom of different shades of rhododendron. The dense forest will be covered with the fragrance of fresh flowers, and birds and animals will enjoy the scent, jumping from one branch to another.

Pikey peak trek is also open for all seasons, including winter and monsoon. However, during monsoon, heavy rainfall can make the trail dangerous as there will be a maximum probability of landslides in the region.

Moreover, the fog will play hide and seek with you by covering the views in an instant and clearing the scenic atmosphere in another instant. The trail is alongside the forest and meadows so that it can be covered with leeches and other various species of insects.

If you make this expedition in the winter, snow will cover all the trails, making it slippery and cold. But the view of snow-capped mountains and blanketed snow villages will be spectacular.
