As you hike from Lukla to the Base Camp, the classic route retraces the steps of Sir Edmund Hillary, Tenzing Norgay, and the numerous other early climbers of Mount Everest.



Given that you are on a **teahouse trek**, you'll stay in some of the world's highest settlements and learn about the Sherpa people's customs and local culture as you explore their religious connection with the Himalayas. Along the way, there are several **Buddhist monasteries** that you may explore to learn more about this religion's rich history and traditions and how closely it is related to the mountains you will be seeing.

The best months to hike to Mount Everest Base Camp are **Autumn - October through November** or **Spring - March through May**. Although going during the winter is not suggested for beginner and intermediate trekkers, the majority of operators offer EBC treks from August through May. With typical daily temperatures of about **10 degrees Celsius** at lower elevations and near freezing at higher elevations, spring and fall give the finest climatic conditions for trekking.

Day 001: A brief flight to Lukla followed by a trek to Phakding

Day 002: Trek to Namche Bazaar

Day 003: Acclimatization Day at Namche Bazaar

Day 004: Trek to Tengboche

Day 005: Trek to Dingboche

Day 006: Trek to Lobuche

Day 007: Trek to Gorak Shep, then to EBC & back to Gorak Shep

Day 008: Hike up to Kala Pattar and trek to Periche

Day 09: Trek to Namche Bazaar

Day 10: Namche to Lukla

Day 11: Fly back to Kathmandu
