The Everest View Trek is a scenic, short-duration trek with magnificent views of **Mt. Everest (8848.86m)**. While other Himalayan region treks include lengthy and strenuous trails, this trek is relatively easy in comparison. This trek is ideal for those who want to experience the beauty of the Himalayas on a limited schedule.

The trip starts with a scenic and adventurous flight from Kathmandu to Lukla. The trail follows



the Dudh Kosi River from Lukla through lush rhododendron forests, local settlements, and monasteries to Phakding. After an overnight stay, you will trek to Namche Bazaar, a vibrant and commercial town of the Khumbu region.

Namche Bazaar offers stunning Himalayan views and is a great place to acclimatize in the region. You will hike to Khumjung, which offers breathtaking views of Mt. Everest, Ama Dablam, Lhotse, and other Himalayan ranges. The Khumjung monastery on top allows you to witness the **Sherpa culture** and their way of life.

On the journey, we will also visit the famous Everest view hotel, where we will have breakfast observing the pristine Himalayas. The trek then returns to Namche and finally to Lukla through the same route before flying back to Kathmandu. However, you will have a different perspective of the mountains and the surroundings this time around.

The 5 day Everest View Hike is relatively easy and is ideal during the Spring and Autumn. The weather is clear, and the views are spectacular during this time of the year. However, if you are feeling adventurous, you can also take this trek in the winter with adequate preparation.

The Everest View Trek is an excellent trekking package to explore the **Himalayan terrain** in a short time. Trekkers will observe the majesty of Mt. Everest and experience the Sherpa culture. The spectacular Himalayas, lush rhododendron forests, and charming villages will enchant you.

Day to Day Itinerary

Day 01: Fly from Kathmandu to Lukla and Trek to Phakding

Day 02: Trek from Phakding to Namche Bazaar

Day 03: Hike to Khumjung, Visit the Everest View hotel and trek to Namche

Day 04: Trek from Namche down to Lukla

Day 05: Fly back from Lukla to Kathmandu

Cost Includes

- All domestic flights and airport taxes.
- Standard meals consisting of breakfast, lunch, and dinner will be provided during the trek.



- A guide holding a government license will accompany the trek.
- For every two people, there will be a strong and helpful porter with proper equipment.
- The guide and porters will receive salaries, food, accommodation, and insurance.
- Tea house/lodge accommodation will be arranged during the trek.
- The trekking group will be provided with a TIMS card for trekking information management.
- The trekking group will be granted a permit for entry into Sagarmatha National Park.
- A comprehensive first aid kit will be available for the trekking group.
- All government taxes and official expenses are included in the package.

Cost Excludes

- The package does not include international airfare and taxes.
- The Nepal entry visa fee is not included and must be arranged separately.
- A compulsory travel insurance policy is required for all participants.
- All personal expenses are the responsibility of the participant.
- Any drinks and desserts during the trek must be paid for by the participant.
