Manaslu and Annapurna Circuit Trek is an incredible expedition that combines two of the mainstream trekking routes of the Himalayan region in a single itinerary. This 20 Day-



Manaslu with Annapurna Circuit Trek takes you across scenic landscapes, popular highlights, religious landmarks, and the vibrant traditional high Himalayan settlements of both Manaslu and Annapurna regions (https://www.marveladventure.com/people-and-culture-of-annapurna-region). Besides the exploration of the Manaslu Conservation Area and Annapurna Conservation Area (https://dnpwc.gov.np/en/conservation-area-detail/68/), you will also take on two of the fascinating high Himalayan passes, like Larkya La Pass [5,106 meters/ 16,751 feet] and Thorong La Pass [5,416 meters/ 17769 feet] in this expedition.

Following the circumnavigating trails around the eight-highest mountain in the world, Mt. Manaslu (https://www.marveladventure.com/manaslu-trekking) [8,163 meters/ 26,781 feet], during the first part of this adventure, you will then move along the exploration of the foothills of the tenth-highest mountain in the world, Mt. Annapurna [8,091 meters/ 26,545 feet]. Manaslu Annapurna Circuit Trek is a remarkable Himalayan adventure if you are looking for an extended adventure to explore the magnificent regions beneath two of the towering massifs in the Himalayas.

Highlights

- A circumnavigating adventure of the two 8,000-meter class mountains in the Himalayas: Manaslu [8,163 meters/ 26,781 feet] and Annapurna [8,091 meters/ 26,545 feet]
- Exploration of the diverse flora and fauna of the Manaslu Conservation Area (est 1998)
 and Annapurna Conservation Area (est 1985)
- Traversing across two high Himalayan passes, Larkya La Pass and Thorong La Pass
- Incredible views of the Himalayan peaks like Manaslu, Lamjung, Annapurna,
 Dhaulagiri, Tukuche, Ganesh Himal, Himchuli and Gangapurna
- Glacial lakes, deep gorges, Himalayan streams, and charming waterfalls of both naturally flourishing regions

- Day 01: Drive from Kathmandu to Machhakhola
- Day 02: Trek from Machhakhola to Jagat
- Day 03: Trek from Jagat to Deng
- Day 04: Trek from Deng to Namrung
- Day 05: Trek from Namrung to Shyala
- Day 06: Trek from Shyala to Samagaun via Pungyen Monastery
- Day 07: Acclimatization at Samagaun
- Day 08: Trek from Samagaun to Samdo
- Day 09: Trek from Samdo to Dharamsala
- Day 10: Trek from Dharamsala to Bimthang over Larkya La Pass
- Day 11: Trek from Bimthang to Dharapani
- Day 12: Trek from Dharapani to Chame
- Day 13: Trek from Chame to Upper Pisang
- Day 14: Trek from Upper Pisang to Manang
- Day 15: Exploration and acclimatization day at Manang
- Day 16: Trek from Manang to Yak Kharka
- Day 17: Trek from Yak Kharka to Thorong Phedi
- Day 18: Trek from Thorong Phedi to Muktinath via Thorong La Pass
- Day 19: Muktinath to Tatopani Drive
- Day 20: Drive from Tatopani to Pokhara
- Day 21: Drive back to Kathmandu on a tourist bus
