The marvelous surrounding views and less trafficked trail ultimatey links with the usual trail. The trek goes on as we cross the suspension bridges and reach Sagarmatha National Park, the UNESCO World Heritage Site. Various rare floras and faunas such as blue pines, firs, rhododendron, Himalayan monal, blood pheasant and musk deer can be seen in the national park. Sherpa cultural attraction is one of the finest attractions linked with the sublime Everest region (https://www.marveladventure.com/everest-trekking). Namche Bazaar, Khumjung and Tengboche are some of the glaring attractions of the Sherpa villages owing to their hospitality, ancient Buddhist monasteries, mani walls and chhortens.
